



Guided Snow Grouse in Finnmark



Tana, Finnmark is well known for a large Grouse population and easily accessible terrain. The terrain varies from the plains and swamps that characterize Finnmark to woody. This differentiated terrain is not only a great biotope, but is also very well suited for hunting with fowling dogs.

- 6 days
- 4-6 hunters
- Can bring own dog

Program:

Day 1: Arrival at Kirkenes airport and transfer. Transport to camp by ATV

Day 2 to 5: Hunting. At end of day 5 you will be transported to hotel for last night.

Day 6: Transport to Airport and Departure

Besides leading you during the hunt, your guide will also act as your host during the campfire meals in the evenings. Local delicacies like king crab, Arctic Salmon, Mountain Trout and Reindeer will be on the menu. The camp consists of a big Lavvu (traditional Sami tent) that hosts all participants in the hunt.
